



## Remote Stereo Viewer (RSV) Self Study

This document is designed to guide users to interact with virtual anatomy using the RSV client. With RSV users can learn where joints, muscles, nerves, arteries, and veins are located in the body. (Figure 1)

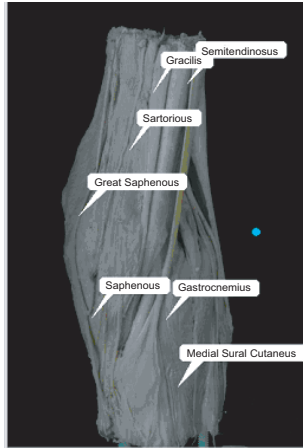

### RSV Setup:

1. Download the zip file to the desktop.
2. Extract the file using the Winzip program:
  - a. Select all the files in the zip window.
  - b. Click the *Extract* icon to add the files to your desktop. **Note:** If you do not have the winzip program download it from to [www.winzip.com](http://www.winzip.com).
3. Open the iAnatomy folder just created and double-click *setup.exe*. A black screen will pop up instructing you to send email with the information. Once you receive an email confirmation, you can begin to use RSV.
4. Open **Internet Explorer 6.0**.
5. Type in: <http://ianatomy.stanford.edu> in the Address box.
6. Put your 3-D glasses on. (Figure 3)

### Using RSV:

1. Select the session of your choice under the Self Study Sessions Section. (Figure 2)

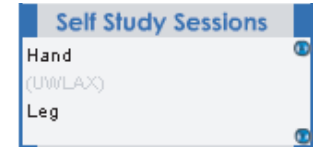

2. To resize the image you may want to maximize the window.
3. Use the arrow keys to navigate through the figure. Use the *Right* and *Left* arrow keys to rotate the figure. Use the *Up* and *Down* arrow keys to peel off the dissected layers one by one.
4. When you are done looking at the figure, right-click on the figure and select **EXIT**.

### Some helpful tips:

- To view labels right-click on the figure and select *Show Labels*. To remove the labels right-click on the figure and select *Hide Labels*. (Figure 5)

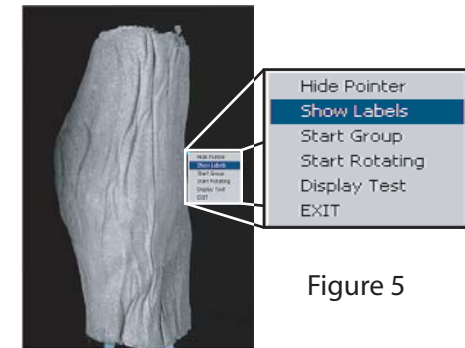

- To hide or show the blue pointer on the screen right-click on the figure and select *Hide Pointer* or *Show Pointer* respectively.
